Re: *Proposed Protocol and Date for Returning to Church, Sunday, June 6, 2021*

Please be patient, prayerful, and kind, as we return to in person church.

Things that we must be prepared to do when we return to in-house church and enter the Sanctuary, (proposed date is June 6th, 2021).

- We will not take the Lord's Supper this first Sunday in June 2021
- Members will gather at the church around 10:00. Services will prayerfully begin at 10:30 AM. Ushers and Greeters will be expected to be in place around 9:30-9:45AM.
- All must enter from the 30th St (front doors). Again, please be patient and prayerful!
- Greeters will wear white on the first Sunday! White gloves are welcomed (every first Sunday)! Greeters, and ushers will wear masks for the good of protecting all.
- All must have on a mask (optional if the family has been fully vaccinated, come together and the ushers sit the family together). Pastor Jackson will give additional exceptions as set by the CDC.
- All must have their temperatures checked. The "temp" must not be over 100° F. All equipment for checking temps belong to the church, including hand sanitizer machine.
- All must have signed a waiver, turn it in to the designated person i/c/w the Church's Insurance Policy!
Waivers are on our gnabc.org web page. Some will be available at the church.
- Greeters will guide members/persons over to an usher who is near the sanctuary.
- Ushers will be in the sanctuary to seat people from the third row (front of the church to the back). Social Distancing will be observed, along with the 3feet apart CDC rule. Minor adjustments will be made as the need arises.
- Contributing your offering, paying tithes, and the like will be handled upon EXITING.
- One may still pay ahead using Givelify, PayPal, Checks, and the like.
- Tentatively, EXITING will be out of the front doors from the Sanctuary; however, if exceptions are made, you will be notified and given any necessary changes!

Our church services will be patterned after the spiritual awakening at Pentecost in the book of Acts 6: 1-7.
